



## ABOUT FINANCIAL AID

### Types of Financial Aid

1. **Scholarships** (based on need and grades)  
When ACPA receives donations for scholarships, candidates are screened and awarded scholarships based on level of need and gpa.

2. **Workstudy Awards** (based on need)  
Each year a handful of families are given workstudy awards that enable eligible students and family members to perform valuable tasks for the school in exchange for a discount on tuition. Duties typically include light custodial, cafeteria help, office support, mowing, and improvement projects.

3. **Sponsorships**  
Occasionally students are able to find someone to "sponsor" their education at ACPA. A sponsorship is money paid by someone else on a student's behalf. Sponsorships are always designated to a particular student.

### HOW TO APPLY

Applicants who wish to apply for financial aid will be asked to fill out an on-line form on the school website. The cost for this application is \$45 per family. ACPA uses this 3<sup>rd</sup> party to analyze financial need. Once the level of need is established, a meeting will be set with each family to discuss options. The steps are as follows:

Students must be accepted into ACPA before financial awards are made.
